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ERS Food Purchase Groups (EFPGs): mappings between detailed scanner data product codes (UPCs) and EFPGs to easily group products, based on the *Dietary Guidelines for Americans*

| | | Breakfast grains | 10050 | Unprepared and unsweetened oatmeal, grits, hominy, farina. Includes quinoa hot cereal and wheat germ |
| | | Flour, bread mixes, and frozen dough | 10075 | Whole grain flour, bread mixes, pancake and biscuit mixes, frozen doughs |

EFPG Uses for Research

- Aggregate estimates for category (e.g., prices or sales volumes)
- Subset data by category
- Consolidate the 91 EFPGs into the 58 Thrifty Food Plan categories (see Carlson et al. 2007)





Monthly Food at Home Price Database (MFAHPD): data on food prices by food category, geographic area, and time period







MFAHPD Description

- Similar to the Quarterly Food at Home Price Database
- 14 geographic areas—10 metropolitan areas and four census divisions
- Categories from the EFPGs
- Currently available for 2016 2018



- Price measures
 - Unit prices (per 100-gram basis)
 - Bilateral price indexes (Laspeyres, Paasche, Törnqvist, and Fisher Ideal)
 - Multilateral price indexes (GEKS, CCD)
- Built using store weights



MFAHPD Uses for Research

- Evaluate changes in food prices over time and across space
- Evaluate differences in food price measures based on substitution and quality controls
- Compare the food costs across geographical regions
