



2024 Summer Internship Program: Frequently Asked Questions

FAQ	Response
When does the internship program start and end?	Our 10-week program kicks off on Monday, June 3 and ends on Friday, August 9, 2024.
What are the qualifications to apply for an internship?	Candidates must be enrolled in or have recently graduated from an undergraduate or graduate program. Rising Juniors/Rising Seniors pursuing a Bachelor's degree and 2nd year Master's students are encouraged to apply.
How can a candidate apply for an internship?	Candidates may apply for an internship through Mathematica's career page: https://www.mathematica.org/career-opportunities
When will internship positions be posted?	We will post available internship positions on a rolling basis on the Career Opportunities page end of January 2024 or beginning of February 2024.
How many hours do interns work?	Interns participating in this program should plan to work 40 hours a week.
Are interns paid?	Yes, we offer only paid internships. We determine compensation rates using a national standard and the intern's academic degree. Typical internship rates range from \$19/hour for undergrad level-interns, to \$22/hour or more for Masters-level interns. Candidates with highly specialized skillsets (for example, highly technical skillsets) may be compensated at rates above \$22/hr.
Is the summer internship in-person or remote?	We intend to offer internships as hybrid or fully remote.
